## 2018-2019 Scholarship Awards Program

*Deadline July 31, 2018*

The Christopher Stallworth Foundation Inc. (CSF), a charitable nonprofit in Georgia announces the 2018-2019 *CSF Scholarship Awards Program*. The Christopher Stallworth Foundation seeks to help low to no income minority students achieve their academic pursuits given the resources available to them. Under the Program, scholarships and grants will be awarded to students enrolled in a 2 or 4 year accredited college/university, vocational/technical school, and other accredited post-secondary program in Georgia.

### Application Requirements

#### *All Applicants*

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at an accredited college, university, vocational, technical or other post-secondary school program for the upcoming academic semester/year. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance with a total family income under \$35,000.
- Applicants must apply for Pell grant.
- Applicants must apply for the 2018-2019 Federal Student Aid Application (FAFSA).
- Applicants must provide page 1 of their 2016 IRS income tax form.
- Applicants must demonstrate responsibility, character, and leadership. CSF Scholarships will be awarded to students who, among other traits, demonstrate responsibility, character, and leadership during their high school/college career including participation in school clubs or school sports teams and a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and support family goals.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **July 31, 2018 by 4:00 p.m. Late applications are not accepted.**
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next semester **only** after their grades from the previous semester have been received.

#### *New Scholarship Applicants:*

- Completed application form.
- Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution. (required from freshmen students ).
- Two references.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- Demonstrated financial need.

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## *Scholarship Renewal Applicants:*

- Scholarships may be renewed annually if entering a full time program, and up to four times for a total of 4 years of study, if recipients maintain a 2.0 average GPA and complete required volunteer hours. More than 4 renewals may be considered on a case by case basis. This presupposes that funds are available for disbursement.
- The scholarship recipient must demonstrate need for continued financial assistance.
- A personal statement describing their experience during their academic year and what they have learned that will help them move forward in life.
- Completed application form.
- The Scholarship recipient must retain permanent residence status in Georgia.
- Students must provide a transcript for consideration. Students should provide an official transcript. Awards will be made provisionally pending receipt of final grades from spring semester of that year.
- Renewal applications are due by December, 2018.

## *Selected recipient:*

- Award notification will be given by mid-December 2018.
- Applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.
- Award amounts will be distributed each semester after a student's final grades are received by CSF

Each letter of recommendation must be signed and sent directly to CSF by the person making the recommendation. Please fill the top part of the recommendation letter before you give it to the teacher/faculty member who is writing your recommendation.
- b) **Proof of college acceptance or current student enrollment.** A letter of college acceptance or program acceptance is required for receipt of funds.
- c) **Most recent official high school or official college transcript.** Photocopies of your transcript are **not acceptable**.
